Friendly reminder: On fieldtrip days, please have your child here as early as possible. We have specific times that we have to leave and be at the places.

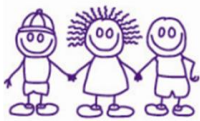
Also if your child isn't going to be here please
