A Word from the Director

This weather has been so wet this month. Our Summer Camp '18 is going to be a Hopefully we'll start getting drier weather soon. If you haven't already, please make sure you change out your child's extra winter clothes for summer clothes. Also, keep in mind that the children are not allowed to wear opentoed shoes in the center without socks and no flip-flops. We do not want stubbed toes or splinters from the playground.

Summer Camp is starting on June 18th and the second half of the summer camp's material and activities fee is due now. Summer camp packets will be going out soon. Please return them and required supplies no later than the 13th of June. This includes swimsuit (girls please have two-piece to wear under our rash guards), towel (bath size), sunscreen (kids SPF 50 continuous spray), swimmers (if applicable), water shoes and hat (optional). Don't forget to label everything with your child's first and last name. Unfortunately, if your child does not have all their supplies they will not be able to participate in any swim or water play activities.

If you would like to volunteer for a fieldtrip or help with pool days, we would love to have you. Please let your child's teacher know if there are any days that work for you.

The end of this marking period was May 31st. Progress Reports will be sent home the 13th of June. You do not need to sign or return anything unless you are requesting a conference.

The last day of public school is Wednesday, June 13th. Summer Camp starts the first Monday after public school gets out (June 18). The weekly summer camp rate for school-age will be \$255.00. If you have any questions, please do not hesitate to ask. Thank you.
