A Word from the Director

Believe it or not we are already starting to get ready for summer camp! Ms. Divina has been working hard and has already got some great shows and fieldtrips lined up. It's sure to be another amazing summer here at Little Learners.

All the children in the T2 class and older currently attending Little Learners will automatically be enrolled in our summer camp. If your child will not be attending summer camp, you will need to let us know **before** we charge your account. Your account will be charged the first half of the activities fee on March 31st. The second half will be due in June. Once the activities fee has been charged to your account it is **non-refundable**. After the 31st of March, we will have open enrollment for children not currently attending Little Learners. Summer Camp forms will be sent out later. If you have any questions or concerns about the summer camp program, please see us in the office.

When public schools are closed or delayed, LLA is usually open. If we do close, we will notify you by text and e-mail, through the Tadpoles app. If you have a school-age child, they are welcome to attend LLA when LCPS are closed or delayed. For closures there is an added fee of \$15.00 for the day. For delays or early closings there is no extra fee. We will make sure the children that attend Steuart Weller get to school and picked up on time. Unfortunately, Steuart Weller is the only school we provide transportation for in the mornings.

If your child will not be attending LLA on days that LCPS are closed, please make sure you let us know. We need to ensure that there is enough staff to service all the children attending.

LCPS will be closed March 29th for a staff development day. If your SA child will be attending LLA, please let us know and remember you will need to pack them a lunch.

If your child is absent from LCPS, please make sure that you notify us before the bus run. You can mark them absent on the Tadpoles app or give us a call to let us know. It's important that you remember to do this so that we are not holding up the bus waiting for your child.

Kindergarten pre-registration for LCPS has already begin. Registration will start on March 20th. For more information you can go to the LCPS website at LCPS.org.

PNO will be held this month on March 15th. When you sign-up your child/ren, please make sure that you only put one child per space. If you get put on the waiting list, we will let you know the week of if you made it in. So far, we've been able to get everyone on the waiting list in 😊.
