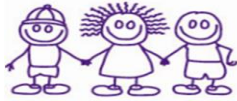

A Word from the Director

We are starting to plan for summer camp, however, due to COVID this is a little challenging since we still do not know exactly what summer camp will look like. Several of the places we have planned to go on fieldtrip to, have already opened their registration, so we will hopefully be lining up some great fieldtrips for the PS/PK and SA classes. We will work around any restrictions, ensure the safety of our children by following all guidelines and make sure we have another amazing summer here at Little Learners.

Summer Camp will run from June 21st-Aug. 20th this year. All the children in the T2 class and older currently attending Little Learners will automatically be enrolled in our summer camp. If your child will not be attending summer camp, please let us know. Under "normal" circumstance your account would be charged the first half of the activities fee on March 31st with the second half being due in June. Since we are still trying to figure out what summer camp will look like and what the fees will be, this will be delayed (hopefully only until the end of April). We appreciate your patience and understanding as we work on figuring out all the details for our summer camp. If you have any questions or concerns about the summer camp program, please call the office.

For our Hybrid Students: When public schools are closed or delayed, LLA is usually open. If we do close, we will notify you by text and e-mail, through the Tadpoles app. If you have a school-age child, they are welcome to attend LLA when LCPS are closed or delayed. For closures there is an added fee of \$15.00 for the day. For delays or early closings there is no extra fee. If there is a delay or early closing, we will make sure the children get to school and picked up on time.

LCPS will be closed Tuesday, March 2nd for a staff development day. If your SA child will be attending LLA please let us know. If they will be absent, please remember to mark them absent on the Tadpole App or call or email us. Weather permitting, we will be taking the kids to one of the local parks for a fieldtrip. If you

have not already done so, please email us permission for your child to attend.

Kindergarten pre-registration for LCPS has already begin. Registration will start on March 17th. For more information you can go to the LCPS website at LCPS.org.

On March 17th we will be celebrating St. Patrick's Day with an all "Green Day" party. You will be receiving an email on what you can contribute. If you have something green in mind that you would like to send in, please reach out to your child's teacher so they can put it on the list. If you are unable to contribute, no worries, just let us know. Don't forget to wear green on this day or you might get pinched.

Every year around this time we have our Annual Egg Hunt. Unfortunately, last year we had to cancel this event because of COVID. This year we are going to try do something special for the kids. We will have our Annual Egg Hunt on Friday, April 2nd. This is during Spring Break, which will allow our school-age children to participate. We will have arts & crafts, refreshments, moonbounce and of course egg hunts! We will send out a schedule for the egg hunts, which will be held on the playgrounds and allow our parents to come watch from outside the fence if they would like. The Easter Bunny will also be visiting us and hiding some eggs.

Spring Break for LCPS and FCPS will be March 29th-April 2nd. Please let us know if your child will be out any days during this time.
